Stimulus Act Could Provide More Transportation Projects for Slack & Co.

Houston, TX— In early 2009, Slack & Co. Contracting, Inc. devised a strategic plan to move forward through economic difficulty. The plan included a push to do more Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) work. On Tuesday, February 17, 2009, President Obama signed The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act into law. The legislation, commonly referred to as the Stimulus Act, includes \$787 billion in government spending, \$68 billion of which could be dedicated to construction projects including water/wastewater facilities, transportation projects and bridge improvements.

Transportation projects funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act are expected to begin quickly and Slack & Co. is prepared to get to work. In the past, the company has completed work for TxDOT, many local municipalities and political subdivisions. Slack & Co. is pursuing jobs in these arenas, making the best of the opportunities created by the stimulus act.
